Court Reporters play a critical role in judicial proceedings, and at legal depositions. They also provide verbatim reports of speeches, conversations, legal proceedings, meetings, and other events when written accounts of spoken words are necessary for correspondence, records, or legal proof. Court Reporters (also known as Transcriptionists, Stenocaptioners, Captioners, Stenotypists, Legal Videographers), are responsible for ensuring a complete, accurate and secure legal record. Many court reporters assist judges and trial attorneys with organizing and searching for information in the official record or making suggestions regarding courtroom administration and procedure.

Court Reporters known as CART (Communications Access Realtime Translation) providers provide closed-captioning and realtime translating services for the deaf and hard-of-hearing community. Others caption television broadcasts or transcribe Web casts or other streaming text on the Internet. Many work flexible schedules and are small business/agency owners.
